FPDI_Protection_128_Pro - Introduction

This script allows you to import encrypted PDF documents with [FPDI](#).

Note: importing a protected document requires to decrypt it, which increases the processing time a lot. This can cause a PHP time-out in some cases, especially if the document contains images or fonts.

FPDI_Protection_128_Pro::setSourceFile()

Description

```
FPDI_Protection_128_Pro extends FPDF {  
    integer setSourceFile ( string $filename[, string $password='') )  
}
```

Opens a file and reads the needed information. It returns the page count. The resulting PDF document is created with the highest version number of the imported documents.

Parameters

\$filename

A valid path to a PDF file you want to take pages from. Only local files are allowed.

\$password

The owner password if the document is encrypted.

Return Values

The page count of the source file.
